FLUID POWER INDUSTRY EXPANDED AT RAPID PACE IN AUGUST

Each month, FPDA Distributors and Manufacturers participate in an online survey conducted by Cleveland Research. Based on data provided by members, a report is prepared and published by Cleveland Research providing a summary of industry conditions and enduser market activity. The September report was recently published incorporating August Data. Here's a quick summary:

FPDA Index Up from July – The August FPDA Index produced a reading of 71.1, up from July's reading of 53.7. This indicates the fluid power industry expanded at a faster pace compared to July. The broader ISM index also showed a slightly lower reading of 50.6 in August, down from the July reading of 50.9.

Demand Remains Robust –Sales growth among fluid power participants rose 20% in August, similar to the 20% growth in July. Distributors saw average sales growth of 25%, up modestly from the 23% growth in July, while Manufacturers growth slowed to 14% growth, following growth of 17% in July. Distributor results are less volatile due to a larger sample size, as well as benefitting from improving MRO activity.

2011 Outlook Unchanged – Participants are projecting full year growth of 20% on average which is unchanged with the outlook offered in our July survey. YTD, overall sales growth has averaged 27%. This implies sales are expected to grow at a modest 6% pace over the final four months of the year.
